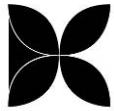

Hawaii: Safe From the Storm?

Bank of Hawaii earned net income of \$192.2 million in 2008, an increase from \$183.7 million of earnings for 2007. Bank of Hawaii's performance measures were consistent with its objectives for 2008. Compared to other banks, the performance of Bank of Hawaii was outstanding.

As economic events unfolded in 2008, it became clear that additional performance measures would also be important. During 2008, Bank of Hawaii strengthened its measures of soundness, even as other financial institutions and business models weakened and failed.
